#### NOTES:

- 1. The candidates for election to fill the current vacancies as Members of the Committee are invited to submit nominations as set out on the sheet attached to this Notice.
- 2. The report from the Joint Chairman, the minutes of the last AGM and the accounts of the Association for the period from 31 December 2011 to 30 December 2012 will be made available to members at the meeting.
- 3. Clause 16 of the Constitution of the Association provides as follows:

"Any member wishing to raise any matter at the Annual General Meeting shall give notice in writing thereof to the Secretary no later than three days before the date of the meeting PROVIDED THAT the Chairman of the meeting may allow any matter to be raised at the Annual General Meeting without such previous written notice as aforesaid".

The ordinary member appointed as a proxy shall be bound to bring to the meeting the instrument appointing him/her as proxy and the power of attorney or other authority (if any) under which it is signed (or a duly certified copy of either), failing which the proxy shall not have the right to cast a vote on behalf of the appointer.
